- Building friendships and managing behaviour
- Negotiating and resolving conflicts
- To show sensitivity to others
- To talk positively about myself and others

PD *physical development*

- Keeping safe, healthy and fit
- Dress for summer and safety in the sun
- Why our body needs water, water safety
- Exploring the setting and woodland
- Using playtime equipment and trikes, cars, scooters and the climbing frame
- Getting changed for PE and using dressing up clothes
- Using simple tools and writing materials to develop fine motor skills
- Finger gym, table top and small world role play, finding treasure
- Outdoor games and using equipment in PE
