Fitzwilliam Museum 28th February 2024

On Wednesday 28th February the year 5 and 6 children from both Kymbrook and Thurleigh schools will be going on an exciting trip to the Fitzwilliam Museum in Cambridge to look at the Egyptian exhibits to enhance their learning this term.

The bus will be leaving the school as soon as the register is taken so please try to be punctual. They will be back to school before 3.20pm (for normal after school arrangements).

The children will need to wear full school uniform and a coat, and bring a packed lunch and water bottle.

While the cost of the actual museum is free, the cost of the transport to take the children on this trip is £400.
