- Create a non-fiction castle information booklet

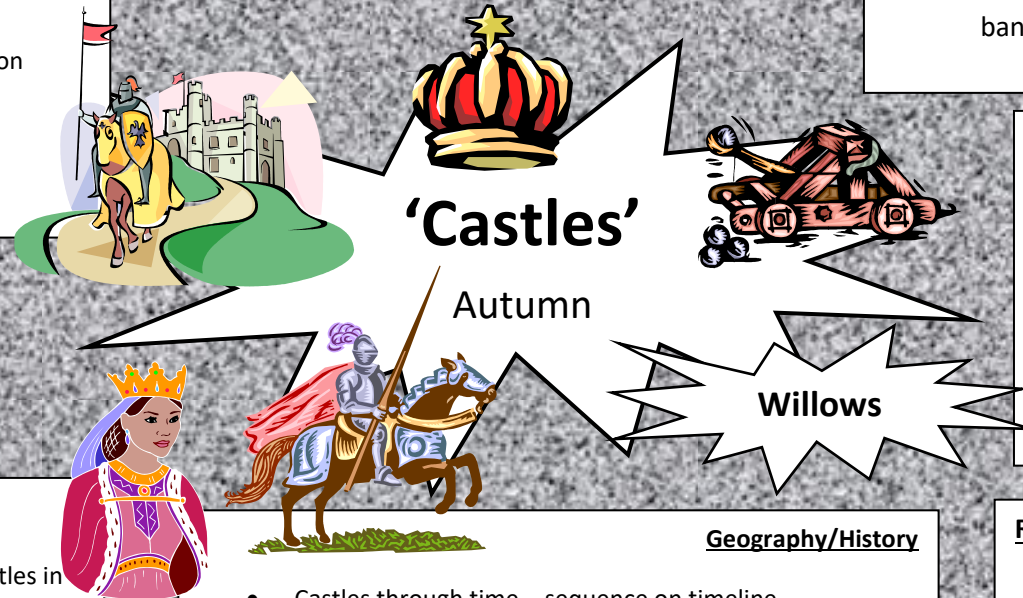
Phys Ed, Wellbeing PHSE
